9. Do you believe the local school district should allow parents to review curriculum and books in the school library?
10. Local control: As California is increasingly overriding local decision-making, would you be willing to stand up to the state in opposition? If so, why and how?
11. What are your thoughts on the teaching of intelligent design?
12. Which politician(s) or leader(s) do you think best reflect your philosophy and why?
13. Should Christian clubs be able to choose Christian leaders for their clubs?
14. Do you believe in absolute truth? Why or why not? If you believe in absolute truth, what is the source of absolute truth? If you do not believe in absolute truth, how do you determine what is true?
